COVID-19. With recent publicity around the COVID-19 virus being detected we wanted to reassure our community that we are following Ministry of Education and Ministry of Health guidelines. We are receiving regular updates and do have a Pandemic Plan that can be quickly activated should we be advised to do so. We recommend following their guidelines and encouraging children to regularly wash their hands for 20 seconds both at home and at school. If your child is unwell please take the time to remind and show them how to either cough or sneeze into a tissue (and then throwing it into the bin) or into their elbow. This helps to reduce the spread of any colds and flus. If your child is unwell please do not send them to school.

Welcome to new students to our school. Our roll is growing and we are excited to get to know all our new families. We remind you that wearing sunhats when outside at break times is compulsory during terms one and four.

School breaks and Bells. Bell times are 8.50am for start of the school day – all children should be in their classroom ready for roll call. 11.00am playtime. Eating time is from 11.20am to 11.30am. Lunch time bell goes at 12.50pm for children's play time, 1.30pm to 1.40pm is lunch eating time. 3.00pm is the end of the school day. We encourage our children to sit down and eat their food at eating times as noted above. Our motto is 'IN THE GATE AT HALF PAST EIGHT GUARANTEES YOU WON'T BE LATE'. This allows children time to get settled, have a run around and be ready for their learning at the start of the day.

What is bullying? We often hear talk of bullying in school and when we ask about it, it is usually in reference to a one-off incident. While we don't condone any instances of being mean (either saying mean things or hurting), and work closely with families and students who are making poor choices, this does not describe bullying. Bullying is ongoing, deliberate and intentional. This could include but isn't limited to, saying mean things, deliberately moving or taking items or excluding your child from games. If you are worried about your child, or concerned about an unsafe situation, please speak to your child's teacher as soon as you can. We would much rather deal with a situation before it becomes bullying. Please encourage your child to tell the teacher when it happens as well, as this allows us to respond to a situation immediately.
