We have processes that are followed when the NZ Police or Ministry of Education put us in to lockdown. In the event of a lockdown we are often working in the dark as much as parents and ask for your patience as we work through the event. But you can be assured that your child's safety and the safety of our staff remains our first priority at all times.

Our community also feels the tragic loss of a Police Officer while on duty and our children have been working on creating cards and letters of condolence to both the NZ Police and the family of the deceased Officer.

Thank you for your support during parent teacher interviews on 17th and 18th June. These conversations are important and we were heartened that so many of our parents were engaged and wanting to hear about their childs' learning.

Although Term 1 and some of Term 2 was unavoidably disrupted due to the COVID-19 virus, we are very proud of our teachers, staff and students response to continue to engage in their learning. We must remember that we are a team and support each other through times that can often be scary.
