Thank you for your patience in supporting our teachers last Wednesday for the national industrial action, and also for supporting teachers' professional development which was held on the Friday 31st May, Staff Only Day. As a school we are working to ensure that all our children are able to access learning support, have a teacher in front of them and the opportunity to progress in their own learning. In this current education environment, we are very lucky that we have been able to contract relievers and our staff are committed to ensuring classes aren't split – this means giving up their own planned non-contact time, however, this is becoming increasingly difficult. Accessing learning support is challenging and significant numbers of children are missing out on the support they need to be successful both in the time it takes and the limited funds that are available. To ensure our children don't miss out, as a community we need to send a message to the government that our children are worth it. If you haven't already, join the 'I back the teachers' Facebook page if you are interested in ways you could support teachers and education, there are some great ideas there. Please don't believe everything in the media in terms of pay increases and what has already been done – the information is misleading and I don't believe it addresses the crisis we are facing.

Ministry of Health - Measles Warning

Measles in Auckland schools

Please vaccinate your child or young person if they have not had one measles (MMR) vaccine. It is free at your GP.

Students in a class with someone who has measles may be asked to stay home for one to two weeks, if they have had no MMR vaccinations.

Students with one or more MMR vaccinations can still attend school.

Check your child's immunisation records in their Well Child/Tamariki Ora book or ring your GP clinic.

Tell your GP or after hours clinic if you suspect measles before you arrive, so you don't infect others.

Symptoms: cough, runny nose, fever, sore red eyes, then a rash.





As the weather changes, and gets more unpredictable sickness becomes more prevalent. If your child is sick it is important to make sure you are keeping your child home.

If your child needs school shoes or a rain jacket, please see Carol in the office or Maria and they can arrange to get these for you.
