Measles – With the number of cases growing in Auckland, it is important we have evidence of MMR vaccinations for all children. Evidence can be emailed to lhs@lincolnheights.school.nz at any time. In the event of an outbreak at our school, children without proof of MMR will be quarantined and unable to attend our school for a period of time as dictated by the Ministry of Health. If you haven't already done so, please send evidence of immunisation to school as soon as possible. We sent letters by post to parents on 23rd August for those children we have no vaccination evidence of.

Math-athon – Our school is the winner again this year with over \$7,000 raised. We are a bit short of our target of \$10 000, so keep the money coming in. The prizes will be given out on Friday at assembly and we will phone families who win a significant prize. Thank you everyone who has supported this important fundraiser that will benefit all of our tamariki.

Carparking. A reminder to please not park on the bus stop outside the gate, or on the yellow lines near the school at any time. There are restricted parking signs on Keegan Drive opposite Lilburn Cres that show hours carparking can be used. To help keep our children safe we suggest you park a little further away and walk to drop off or collect your child, or alternatively use the Doone Place entry. Parking officers have been contacted and will be in our area soon.
